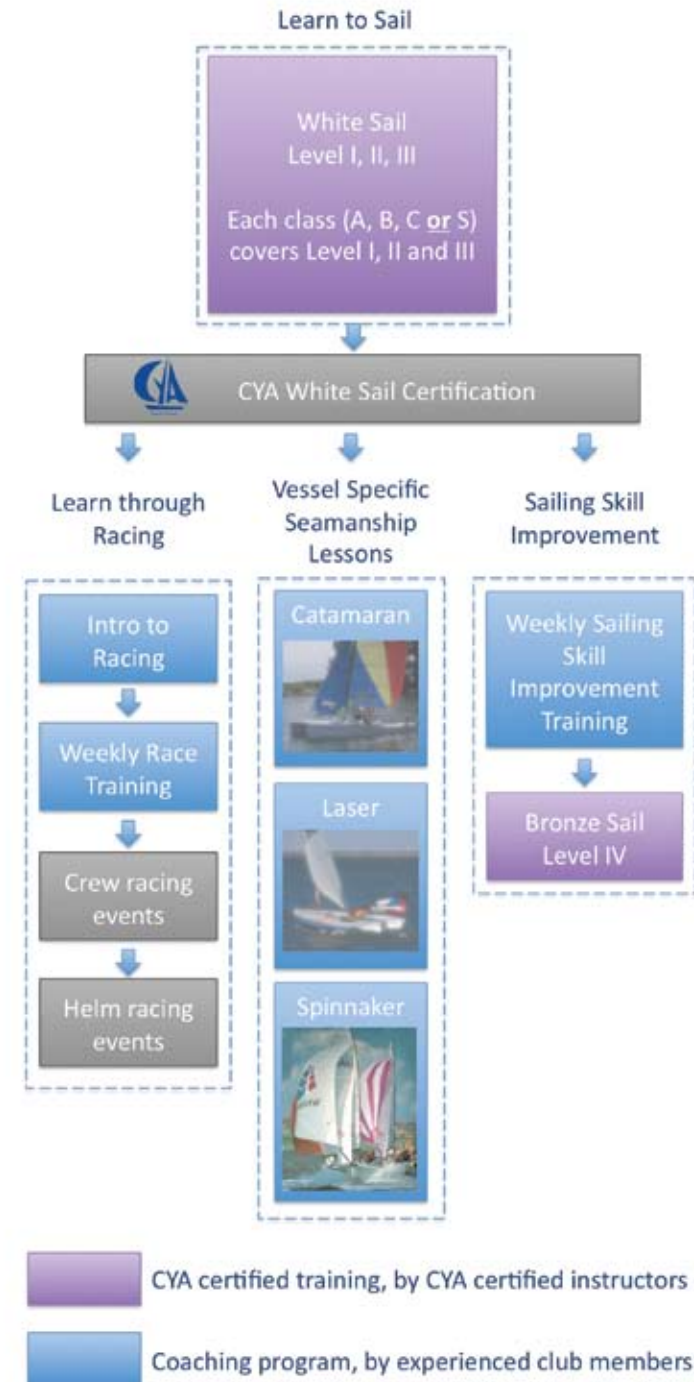
Learn Sailing: from the Basic to Advanced Sailing Lessons

At Mooredale, we love sharing our passion for sailing. Our enthusiasm is quickly infectious for most new members. We love seeing our students enjoying the thrill of sailing well and fast! For these reasons, we put together a sound teaching program unique to our club.

All the basics of sailing are covered in the White Sail Program. Each session (A, B, C or S) covers White Sail levels I, II, and III. See application form for lesson schedule.

Our classes are taught by certified Canadian Yachting Association instructors. All graduates will become club skippers, i.e. able to take a boat out unsupervised with another sailor. The White Sail program includes a Water Safety session in a local pool, weeknight classes (6-10pm), or weekend classes (10am-4pm), Also offered are Basic Maintenance seminars, Laser/Hobie rigging, and Intro to Racing classes. Returning members are welcome to attend all land-based seminars

without being enrolled in a White Sail session. The organigram gives you a snapshot of our Training at Mooredale Sailing Club:

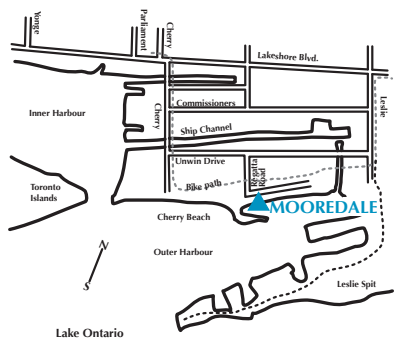


Wide range of club-owned sailboats

Racing

Mooredale partners with five other local clubs in offering the following racing programs for Mooredale-members.

- a. Friday Night Series – The race often has over 50 boats and the clubs take turns hosting a light dinner afterwards where prizes are awarded.
- b. Harbour Master Series – every 2nd Sunday, two back to back races are held with each club taking turns hosting.

c. Regattas – each club hosts a one-day Saturday regatta consisting of several races complete with a great dinner and dance. In addition there are several other available regattas available for participation.
